

INFORMATION AND STUDENT CONSENT

Subject: Information pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 and Article 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679.

Pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (hereinafter "Privacy Code") and Article 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 (hereinafter "GDPR 2016/679"), containing provisions for the protection of persons and other subjects with regard to the processing of personal data, we wish to inform you that the personal data you provide will be processed in compliance with the above-mentioned legislation and the confidentiality obligations to which COREP is bound.

Data Controller

The Data Controller is COREP Torino in the person of the President and legal representative, domiciled for this purpose at the registered office of the organisation.

Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The Data Protection Officer (DPO) is Dr Davide Caregnato, procurator of the Organisation and domiciled for the purpose at the registered office of the same.

Purposes of the processing

The personal data provided by you are necessary for the fulfilment of legal obligations. In particular, they are necessary in order to fulfil the purposes of the master/course in which you have enrolled and any obligations connected with the fulfilment of fiscal and accounting obligations, promotional and marketing information, the evaluation of the degree of satisfaction with the service offered to you, market analysis and surveys and educational evaluation and any other necessary fulfilment foreseen.

Processing and storage methods

Processing will be carried out in automated and/or manual form, in compliance with the provisions of Article 32 of GDPR 2016/679 and Annex B of Legislative Decree 196/2003 (Articles 33-36 of the Code) regarding security measures, by specially appointed persons and in compliance with the provisions of Article 29 GDPR 2016/679. We would like to inform you that, in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimisation, pursuant to Art. 5 GDPR 2016/679, subject to your free and explicit consent expressed at the foot of this information notice, your personal data will be kept for the period of time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are collected and processed.

Data communication and dissemination

We also inform you that collected data will never be disseminated and will not be communicated without your explicit consent, except for necessary communications that may involve the transfer of data to public bodies, consultants or other parties for the fulfilment of legal obligations.

Transfer of personal data

Your data will not be transferred either to member states of the European Union or to third countries outside the European Union.

Special categories of personal data

Pursuant to Articles 26 and 27 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and Articles 9 and 10 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, you may provide COREP Torino with data that can be qualified as "special categories of personal data", i.e. data revealing "racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, as well as genetic data, biometric data intended to uniquely identify a natural person, data concerning a person's health or sex life or sexual orientation". These categories of data may be processed by COREP Torino only with your free and explicit consent, given in signing this information notice.



Existence of automated decision-making process, including profiling

COREP Torino does not adopt any automated decision-making process, including profiling, referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) of EU Regulation No. 679/2016.

Rights of the data subject

At any time, you may exercise, pursuant to Article 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and Articles 15 to 22 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, the right to: a) request confirmation of the existence or non-existence of your personal data; b) obtain information about the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated and, when possible, the storage period; c) obtain the rectification and deletion of the data; d) obtain the restriction of processing; e) obtain the portability of the data, i.e. receive them from a data controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and transmit them to another data controller without hindrance; f) object to the processing at any time and also in the case of processing for direct marketing purposes; g) object to automated decision-making concerning physical persons, including profiling h) request from the data controller access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning him or her or to object to the processing of personal data, as well as the right to data portability; i) withdraw consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on consent given before the revocation; j) make a complaint with a supervisory authority.
