

## ***Federico Consulich short academic and professional profile***

On January 2008 Federico Consulich obtained the title of Doctor of Research in Italian and Comparative Criminal Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Pavia, with vote “*Excellent*”, discussing a doctoral thesis entitled “*The Criminal Protection of Wealth. A Study on Criminal Law and Public Saving in Italian Legislation*”.

Since July 2012 he is researcher at the University of Genoa.

Since October 2013 he is aggregate professor of commercial criminal law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Genoa.

Since December 2014 he is associate professor of criminal law at the University of Genoa.

Since March 2020 he is a member of the Doctoral College entitled *Security, Risk and Vulnerability – Security and Law* curriculum, at the University of Genoa.

Since November 2020 he is full professor of Criminal Law at the University of Genoa.

Since December 2022 he is full professor of Criminal Law at the University of Turin, and member of the Doctoral College entitled *Law and Institution*, at the same University.

His main research interests are criminal law, criminal justice, economic criminal law, constitutional criminal law, and criminology.

He wrote three monographies and over eighty among articles of legal doctrine, chapters of collective volumes and handbooks, both in Italian and in English.

Prof. Consulich has been admitted to practice as a Lawyer in Italy (to the Bar of Milan) since 2009 and admitted to the Bar of Italian Supreme Court since 2019.

He provides legal assistance, advice and judicial defense in the field of business criminal law (areas of practice: bankruptcy, tax, environmental, financial and corporate offenses, as well as criminal cases related to the infringement of occupational safety regulations).

He also advises companies and other private entities within the framework of the criminal liability of corporations pursuant to Legislative Decree 231/2001 (in the fields of large-scale distribution, construction and major infrastructure).

He is involved in the development of compliance programs (Modelli organizzativi) of relevant Italian companies.
